News from Your Board of Directors

"Weekend Support Staff" Established

The Emmaus Board has decided that a "Weekend Support Staff" team will be established for each Emmaus Weekend in the future. This Staff will serve in an "Out of Conference Room" capacity and in the background, avoiding contact with Pilgrims as much as possible.

The staff's responsibilities will change as each weekend's needs change. The Emmaus Board will choose the Support Staff Leader who will, in turn with the Logs, Kitchen, Agape, Supplies and Community Coordinators assist as needed during the weekend. Some of the duties will include but not be limited to: set up and tear down for Weekend Picture, "Dying Moments Communion," Chapel Visits, decoration of the dining room, replacing sleeping areas for Sunday School, assistance with Kitchen and Supplies inventory at the conclusion of the weekend, set up of Sanctuary for closing, return of Sanctuary to original condition after close, and making sure the facility is in proper order before leaving. The Support Staff would be the last ones to leave a facility at the end of a Walk.

Support staff can be either male or female and can serve as they are available. Individuals can serve for an hour, a day or the weekend - whatever time they can spend. It is suggested that community members from the local area (where the Walk is held) be the members of the Support Staff, but any members of the WNY Community are welcomed and encouraged to participate.

The Support Staff Leader will be the same for both Men's and Women's weekends.

Decision Concerning Minimum Number of Pilgrims and Caterpillars
