The Picnic will be Saturday, July 17th from 1:00-5:00pm. at the GENESEE County Park in East Bethany. Please bring your own table service, drinks, and a dish to pass. Meat will be provided. There will be food, fellowship, singing, games for the young and young at heart. Bring your entire family for the afternoon! There is a playground close by and miles of hiking or biking trails. We will be meeting in picnic area "D", (the same as last year), which has a covered pavilion and grills. The park is located off Raymond Road in sunny East Bethany. There are signs pointing to the GENESEE County Park as you drive along Route 20, as well as some in the park to guide you.

DIRECTIONS:

From the West, take Route 20 thru Alexander about 4 miles. Turn on to Bethany Center Road (there is a blue road sign guiding this turn). Travel south on Bethany Center Road until you reach Raymond Road, which is the first cross road. Turn left onto Raymond Road. The park entrance will be on your right.

From the East, take Route 20 from Route 390 in East Avon. Stay on Route 20 until you reach East Bethany Road. This will be the first intersection after you travel thru the Route 63 intersection. Travel south on East Bethany Road to Raymond Road, which is your first right. The park entrance will then be on your left as you travel down Raymond.

Board Positions Opening in 2005

The Walk to Emmaus is a Lay movement that requires the involvement of the Emmaus community in leadership positions for it to be effective. There are amazing gifts and talents in our community and one way we can share these is through serving on the Western New York Walk to Emmaus Board of Directors.. Several Board positions will change in January 2005. New positions need to be filled in September so that the new people will have an opportunity to "train" during the fall walks.

To be on the Board you can nominate anyone who has a desire to serve God through Emmaus- it could be yourself. Each position can be filled singularly or as a couple. Meetings are held the third Friday of every month at Trinity UMC in Attica, NY at 7:00 pm.

Each of these positions is held for three years.

The positions and job descriptions are listed below.

Secretary - responsible for minutes of monthly Board meetings, maintains computer information lists of pilgrims, teams, address list of community. Chris Collins is the current Secretary (585-227-1519)

Treasurer - maintains financial records for WNY Emmaus, reports monthly to Board on receipts and expenses, year-to-date Actual v. Budget report. Prepares budget. Steve and Pat Morse are the current Treasurers. (585-798-1605)

Newsletter - serves as editor of the "Rainbow Connection" (monthly newsletter). Most articles are submitted by e-mail and put into newsletter format. Oversees printing, assembling, labeling, mailing. Jim Moody is the current Editor of the "Rainbow Connection." (585-637-7947)

Kitchen - responsible for scheduling laborers and food for teamings, walks and flights, Christmas party and picnic. Maintains and is responsible for all kitchen supplies. Pam and Jeff Mellon are the current Kitchen Coordinators. (716-372-1836)

Music - encourage and develop new Emmaus musicians through workshops and arrange for music at send-off, candlelight, closing services, reunions. Maintains an updated musicians list and our local Western New York songbook. Mike and Jan Mortimer are the current Musician Chairpersons. (716-373-2237.)

Spiritual Director - The Spiritual Director is elected by the Community from among the clergy persons who have been involved in the Walk to Emmaus movement in WNY. The Spiritual Director acts as spiritual leader to keep the community focused on the purpose of the Emmaus movement.
